**12:00 PM 25° with moderate snow. About 1/2 inch on the ground, snowfall approaching 1 inch per hour. Called John to come in for a salt run.**

**2:00 PM 26° with moderate snow. We have about 2 to 3 inches on the ground. Have called everyone to come in and start plowing. John is about 3/4 done the salt route and does not see anyone having issues with driving.**

**2:30 PM 27° with moderate snow. Everyone is on their routes.**

**4:15 PM 28° with light to moderate snow. Looks to be ending here shortly. Will let everyone finish their routes, grab some super, then we will clean up all routes.**

**6:00 PM everyone is in for supper. After supper will continue cleaning up the routes and treating for the night.**

**9:00 PM everyone completing their routes. Albert's and Johns have been scraped and treated complete. Allen and Bob's have been scraped and treated for hills corners and intersection. Bob and Allen will be in at 5:00 Am to complete. Storm is over with an accumulation of 4 inches.**
