STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

4:30 AM 10.5° with light to moderate snow. About 1 inch on the ground so far. Forecast still calling for 8 to 12 inches of snow, sleet and freezing rain before this is over. Temps are colder then I anticipated, maybe that is a good sign. Will call the guys at 5:00 AM to come in and get all set up.

6:00 AM 10° with 2inches on the ground. Everyone is in and getting their trucks ready. We will begin plowing as soon as they are hooked up and going.

6:30 AM 10° with 3 inches of snow on the ground. Heavy snow greater then 1 inch per hour. So far all crews still working without any problems. Lost 1 windshield wiper on Chevy, but should not be a problem.

9:00 AM 10.5° with heavy snow, snowfall rate is greater then 1 inch per hour. Over 6 inches on the ground so far, probably nearing 7 at this time. Every one is on their routes and working. Little traffic out, mostly people headed to get their Sunday

paper. Trucks are finishing up first round and immediately heading around again. Sleet is starting to mix in with the snow.

10:30 AM 12° with steady sleet. Backhoe will not start, will need to plow buildings with the pickup for now.

12:00 PM Backhoe is running, Wayne will start plowing parking lots.

1:30 PM 15° with light sleet and snow. 9 inches so far. Albert, Allen and John have finished lunch and headed to treat the main roads on their routes. Forecast still calling for a change to freezing rain around 4PM. seems to be moving back a little. Will let the sleet and snow stay on the roads for when the freezing rain comes. Bob completed his second round and getting lunch

2:30 PM 17° with light snow. Everyone is back in, will clean up the yard and bays while we wait to see if we will get freezing rain in a couple of hours.

3:30 PM 17° with light snow. Allen, John and headed home to get supper and come back at 5:30. Wayne headed home till 3:00 AM. Albert and Bob will keep an eye on traffic then switch at 5:30 PM.

5:30 PM 19° with light freezing rain. Albert and Bob are headed home for supper and rest. Allen and John will split the town up and keep an eye on things. Will meet with them at 8:00 PM and see how to proceed.

8:00 PM 22° with the moon breaking through. Allen and John will plow off their routes, I will call Albert and Bob at 11:00 for the same.

12:00 AM light flurries. Allen and John done their routes and in for a rest till 4, Albert and Bob are cleaning up their routes in preparation for School.

3:00 Am Wayne in start cleaning buildings and walks.

4:00 AM Albert, Allen treating their routes, they will pick up parts of Johns as they work their way around. John will do a salt run first thing.

8:00 AM Everyone done their routes, storm is over with a total of 10 inches.
