STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

1:30 PM 26° with snow/sleet mixed. Having everyone treat their entire routes with 10:1 salt sand mix. All paved roads were pre-treated with mag chloride at a rate of 30 gallons per mile early this morning. We will be holding off on any plowing, forecast is calling for an ice storm later this afternoon.

3:00 PM 26° with mostly sleet. No problems encountered, all trucks working. Will continue treating till routes are done or freezing rain begins. Forecast still calling for freezing rain by 4 PM.

4:15 PM all routes are done, its 25.5° with steady sleet. Everyone is in getting supper then we will head around again to check for commuters having trouble.

5:00 PM everyone is back on the road.

6:00 PM 27° with freezing rain starting. Everyone is finishing 2nd round and headed for fuel and saws.

8:00 PM 26° with off and on sleet and freezing rain. We really can't wait any longer. Everyone will start scraping their routes one area at a time. They will treat right after it is plowed. Called Wayne to come in for the walks.

10:00PM 28° with heavy rain. Current rain rate of ½ inch an hour. All crews are still plowing off routes. Had to have one car removed in the center of town. PD attempted to locate the owner and was unsuccessful. PD to call Johnsons to have the car removed.

11:30 PM Jon off the road on Orchard. Albert will try to pull him out.

12:00 AM Just hit 32°, still have a fairly steady rain. Gravel and walks are going to be impossible to move until tomorrow. Wayne is trying to free up the steps to the town office then will call it quits till tomorrow. Jon back on the road. 0.92 inches of rain so far.

2:00 AM Everyone in till 6:00 AM for a rest. All roads have been plowed, some will need treatment in the morning.

6:00 AM 34° with heavy wind. Everyone is up and going. Albert and Bob will plow the dump then pull their plows. Everyone will treat their routes.

9:30 AM John will load up and run a line of slat on the main roads to help break up the ice. Everything has been treated, almost all roads have some type of ice build up on them. Everyone will be back at 6:00 AM tomorrow morning to re-sand all routes. Total accumulation was about 2 inches of sleet and ½ inch of freezing rain and ice.
