STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

11:30 PM 19° with moderate snow, about 2 inches on the ground. Called everyone to come in and start plowing.

12:30 AM Bob and Jon on the road at 12:30, Allen has 2 stripped lugs, him and Albert are changing, should be on the road by 1:00 AM.

1:30 AM 19° Allen reports a car in the turn around at prospect hill (NH 255-2825), Contacted Dispatch to call the owner and have it removed. Snow is mixing with sleet periodically.

4:00 AM 20° with moderate to heavy snow. Everyone is finishing up their routes. Jon needs to comeback and change a fitting on his plow. Everyone will be heading around again after getting fuel and coffee.

4:30 AM School has been canceled. Allen in to adjust his tire chains then he will be headed around again.

5:30 AM 22° with heavy sleet. We have about 6 inches of snow on the ground. Sleet came in steady about a ½ hour ago.

7:30 AM 25° with sleet and freezing rain. Everyone is trying to clean up their routes before the heavy rain.

9:00 AM 31° with freezing rain at the rate of .4 inches per hour. Roads that have been plowed are icing over. All trucks still trying to clear their routes, becoming impossible to move the snow.

10:00 AM 31° with heavy rain. The F-550 is down for clutch problems, not sure what is wrong. Will be pulling it in diagnose. The F-550 is down for the storm, will be sending it to the shop on a wrecker.

12:00 PM 32.8° with steady rain. We have had 2 inches of rain since this storm began. Everyone will be coming in for lunch and then headed out pushing back. Jon will be in the backhoe opening up water bars.

1:00 PM Post Office called and reported a flooded basement. Jon to head with the backhoe and open up the bulkhead.

2:00 PM Jon and Kurt clear of the post office, left a sump pump in the basement. Jon will continue to open up snow banks, Allen, bob and Albert pushing back the gravel and opening up snow banks. 2.45 inches of rain since this started.

4:00 PM 33° with moderate rain. We have had lights flickering and tree limbs coming down. Temps are forecasted to fall overnight. Allen and Jon are attempting to open snow banks while Bob and Albert are tending to gravel roads. 2.73 inches of rain.

5:00 PM Bob off the road on High Street. Gravel is definitely icing over. Will have Allen pull him out.

6:00 PM 39.9° with light rain. Bob is back on the road. Everyone will be treating their routes while Jon is still opening up snow banks. Everyone will try to grab a bite to eat when they can.

10:00 PM all routes have been sanded, Middle road was scraped with the grader and Jon has opened up as much as he can. Everyone is shutting done for the night and will be back at 5:00 AM we had about 8 inches of snow and sleet and an additional 2.25 inches of rain for 2.91 inches of precipitation.
