**STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:**

**2:00 AM 17° with moderate snow. We have about 2 inches of snow on the ground. Will call everyone to come in and start plowing off their routes.**

**3:00 AM Everyone is up and running and on their routes.**

**4:45 AM Jon reports a broken spring hanger on his truck. He will bring it back to the barn and replace it, I will pick up his roads he ahs not plowed yet.**

**5:45 AM 19° with light to moderate snow. Jon is in fixing the F-550, Kurt just finished his route. We will not be able to plow the end of Bittersweet, there is a car right in the middle of the road at the Mack residence. I had reported this car to the PD last week, I will wait till they come on at 8 to see if they can make additional contact. Kurt will be plowing the buildings with the backhoe.**

**7:00 AM 19° with about 6 inches on the ground. Everyone has had breakfast and is heading around again.**

**10:30 AM** all routes have been plowed a second time. No reports of any problems. Everyone will grab something to eat and wait for the last of the squalls to end before cleaning up.

**12:00 PM** everyone is on their routes and cleaning up. All buildings are completed.

**3:00 PM** all routes are plowed, Jon is doing a salt run in the shady spots the others are treating.

**5:00 PM** everyone is done and headed home. 6 inch storm.

**Special Note:** we just broke 100 inches of snow. Rich has recorded 101 inches in Peterborough.
